FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC

The City of Reading, Ohio Civil Service Commission is testing to create an eligibility list for the full-time position of FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC with the Reading Fire Department. Examination will be 9:00 a.m., March 10, 2018 in the City of Reading Council Chambers located at 1000 Market Street, Reading, Ohio 45215

Applications are available at www.readingohio.org or at the City General Offices, on the second floor of the Reading Municipal Building, Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Applications must be filed with the City Clerk by Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. A ten (10) dollar application fee (cash/check) must be submitted with the application to take examination.

Requests for the additional credit for military service (20% of passing grade), together with a DD-214 form confirming honorable discharge shall be submitted with the application. Additional credit (10% of passing grade) will also be given for current service as a non-probationary paid-on-call or part-time member of the Reading Fire Department. Total additional credit cannot exceed 20%.

A valid Ohio Driver's License must be presented on the day of testing, to sit for examination.

Applicants must have proof of Ohio Department of Public Safety Paramedic and Firefighter 2 (FF2) certifications at time of appointment; must obtain Ohio Fire Safety Inspector (FSI) certification within one year of appointment; must furnish proof of two year's firefighting experience; must be able to pass a physical agility, medical physical, and polygraph examination; and possess a valid Ohio Driver's License.
